### 50th Anniversary of the launch of Aryabhata

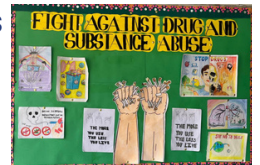
On 19th April, the school hosted an online webinar to mark 50 years of Aryabhata's launch, celebrating India's space achievements and honouring this historic milestone.
